



Perth Diamond Jubilee Parade 2nd June 2012

Thank you for supporting the Perth Diamond Jubilee Parade.

Timings:

10:00am: Pipe Bands and individual players please schedule to arrive in Perth by 10:00am at the latest. There will be designated bus drop-off and pick-up points.

11:00am: Parade start

12:00pm: Parade end at North Inch.

12:00pm: Massed Pipe Bands at North Inch.

12:25pm: Massed Pipe Band end. Pipe Bands are then free to enjoy the afternoon.

12:30pm: Big Lunch – pack lunch will be served to all players

12:30pm – 4:15pm: Live Music Stage

4:15pm: Spitfire fly-over.

Parade Ranks: Please form-up in ranks six across.

Parade Blocks: The parade is divided into blocks. (See parade order for your block number).

Parking: Bands arriving by bus, mini-bus may request a free pass to allow them access to drop-off at Rose Terrace (adjacent to North Inch). Buses will then be directed by stewards to free parking at park at South Inch. Private cars are requested to park at South Inch. Please leave plenty of time to get to Perth.

First Aid / Control Centre:

This is position at North Inch adjacent to Barossa Place. (Right-hand side of main stage on North Inch). If first aid assistance is required please notify stewards who will be able to radio for assistance.

Parade Position:

The ACF will be fourth in the parade and will be playing as a unit. They are free to select their own tunes during the parade. (See parade route below).

Massed Pipe Bands – North Inch:

The bands will form-up at the end of the parade at North Inch in one large massed pipe band as directed by stewards. Tunes announced across the PA will include:

- Green Hills, Battle's O'er (marching)
- Scotland the Brave (marching)
- Amazing Grace (static)
- The Black Bear (march-off)
